Dental Exam Information:

Illinois State Law **REQUIRES** all children entering an Illinois school present written proof of a dental examination performed and signed by a licensed dentist. The dental exam is required by March 1st 2012 of the Kindergarten, 2nd and 6th grade school year. It can be as early as November 15, 2011. Attached is the Illinois State mandated dental form, no other forms will be accepted.

We ask that the completed dental record be returned to the school office as soon as possible, and no later than March 1st 2012.
