

St. Hubert Youth Ministry 2012 Summer Mission Trip

Winnebago, Nebraska
July 22-28, 2012

What is a mission trip?

A mission trip is an exciting, week long service-learning experience designed to help teens change their perspective so that they can change the world. It provides an opportunity for teens to meet people from across the country by working together and living in community. And most importantly, it is an opportunity to spend a week in service to those who really need our help. And, it is also a lot of fun!

What will we be doing?

The trip is organized by a group called Young Neighbors in Action. YNIA arranges for the work-site, provides food and housing during the week, and plans fun, educational activities during the evenings. Final details of our work activities are not known until closer to the actual trip, but the types of service we may be a part of include:

- Clean-up, paint-up, fix-up, construction and repair
- Assist with daycare or summer camp programs, family centers, etc.
- Cooking/serving meals in homeless shelters, working with food banks, etc.

Who can come?

Teens that are currently in grades 9-12 are eligible to participate in the mission trip.

What is the cost?

Any additional money needed for the week (travel day lunch/dinner and misc. expenses) is the responsibility of the teen.

NOTE: Don't let the cost keep you from participating. If you would like to attend, but the cost is a burden to your family, please contact us and we will find a sponsor for your trip.

What do I need to do now?

- The St. Hubert Youth Ministry Registration Form and the non-refundable deposit are required in order to reserve your spot on this trip. **The deposit is \$75 and is due by Friday, September 30.** (Please make checks payable to St. Hubert.) Don't wait! Space is limited and we are expecting a waiting list.
- All participants are required to participate in pre-trip activities (fundraising, meetings, team-building, etc.). The first gathering will be Wednesday, January 12 for parents and teens.
- We need to fundraise to help defray the cost of the trip. Our minimum goal is to raise \$200 per person. We would like to raise more than that goal, but that is where we need your help. We are looking for people to organize these individual fundraising activities to help us achieve our goal. The more assistance we receive and the more money we raise, the better chance we have of decreasing our overall cost per person for the trip.
